Rules:

Entry fee for Queen Mallard is \$60 for beauty and \$20 for photogenic. Deadline to enter is November 6, 2021. Any entries after this date will include a \$15 late registration penalty and will not be listed in the program book or be pictured in the newspaper.

Queen Mallard contestants will compete in interview, evening wear, and photogenic (optional). There will also be an award given for Miss Congeniality, Crowd Favorite and Overall Interview Award. The newly crowned winner will be required to attend activities scheduled by the Queen Mallard Committee at the Wings Over the Prairie Festival and at events scheduled throughout her reign.

Contestant must be between the ages of 16 and 21 the day of the pageant and must reside in the counties of Arkansas, Lonoke, Monroe, Prairie and Jefferson.

Rehearsal for the pageant will held at 8:30 am on November 20, 2021 at Stuttgart Junior High School Auditorium. **PLEASE BE ON TIME** so that everyone will have enough time to prepare for their interview. If you do not attend rehearsal, you will be disqualified from the competition that night and no refund will be given. Interviews will be held that afternoon. Venue and times will be assigned at rehearsal. If you are late for your interview, you will not be allowed to make it up. So please be on time!

Contestants selected for the Top 10 will be required to answer an on-stage question.
